Thank you to everyone who helped to fold, string and hang the origami cranes for the sanctuary. Each Peace Crane represented Maine individuals who lost their lives to Covid-19. They were a reminder to pray for peace for the families left behind and those who are currently ill. They hung in the sanctuary from November 2020 to April 2021.

Currently, our 700 plus cranes join thousands of other paper cranes hanging in the Matter Studio Gallery in Los Angeles, CA. They are now part of the Memorial Crane Project which honors all Americans who died from the Covid-19 virus.
