On Sept. 18, the candidate will preach and the congregation will vote. If the vote is favorable, the settled pastor will begin on November 27, the first Sunday of Advent. If the vote is not favorable, the search will begin again.

Thank you all for your patience through our search process. Thank you for pitching in where needed. Together we were able to keep our church functioning through the past 6 months. It could not have happened without the support of everyone.

Many prayers have paved the way for a new pastor. The wait of knowing the name of our candidate is over and it is someone that many of you know. Neil Wilson and his wife, Donna, are coming home to Lovell. Here is the biographical information to let you know what Neil has been doing the last 30 plus years.

We are delighted to introduce Rev. Neil H. Wilson as candidate for pastor of our church. He is an ordained minister in good standing with the United Church of Christ. Neil "comes" to us after serving six churches in Maine, Indiana, Michigan and New Hampshire. But, for some of you, you know that Neil has "come home" to serve here in Lovell.

He was born and raised in Lovell, attending the Lovell United Church of Christ. He attended Sunday School and church here listening to his mother, Mary, as the church organist. He married Donna Walker and lived here in town with their two children while he ran his own logging business. He was called to the ministry; mentored and encouraged by several retired ministers attending LUCC. In 1986 he began serving his first church, Dixfield Congregational Church, Dixfield, Maine. Two churches followed in Indiana before they came back to Maine in 2005 to serve the Maine Seacoast Mission in Cherryfield. From there they moved to Michigan and currently he is serving the Congregational Church of Laconia, Laconia, NH. His experience is varied from very rural communities to the challenges of a small city in Laconia.

Neil and Donna have decided to retire to their home here in Lovell. His life in retirement wouldn't feel right without serving a church and community; our part time position is a perfect fit. If called, he will begin his time here with us on Sunday, November 27, 2022.

Here are just a few of the gifts Neil brings with him, although there are many: mission work, rural church leadership, visitation, outdoor ministries, counseling, crisis response and intervention through Victim Services training and on duty experience.

In his own words, "As a pastor, I seek to be a listener and comforter when needed, a prophet and priest when necessary and above all else, a Christian companion as we journey together on the path of life."
