Dear friends,

I thought I would take this month to highlight a couple of the ministries of this church and the impacts they have beyond this church. After all, the church should be an organization whose purpose is to benefit those beyond its walls as much if not more than those within its membership. These are activities that are often mentioned in the Circuit Rider that might be good to go into a little more depth than just open hours and lists.

One of the focuses of our church's Mission committee is the support of both of our Lovell and Sweden Food Pantries. Beyond the usual food items collected, we have learned that the needs of our neighbors can be for items other than edible. So, we also collect consumables like laundry and dish soap, shampoo and bath soap, paper towels and toilet paper. We gather these items in the church vestry and deliver them to the food pantries on a monthly basis.

The second ministry to highlight is the Thrift Shop. The Thrift Shop is a true community effort. There are approximately 40 volunteers from both church and the community, seasonal and year-round residents.

Beyond providing good quality used clothing and household items at a reasonable cost (the \$2 bag days!) the Thrift Shop supports organizations like Apparel Impact, (see www.apparelimpact.com for more information), books for our local PTA, Preble Street Mission, free children's books for families during school vacations, emergency supplies for teachers, emergency clothing for homeless, emergency assistance victims of fire/flood, in short if a need is known the Thrift Shop is there to help in whatever means they can.

The next time you visit the Thrift Shop on your way down the stairs take a look at the sign on the left for a more complete list of the many ways the Thrift Shop benefits our community.

These are just a couple of the ministries of the Lovell United Church of Christ as we seek to be the hands, feet, eyes and ears of Christ in our local communities and beyond.
